Supply lists

The following will be provided for you if you register for the **With Supplies** packages. If you plan on bringing your own supplies, know that slight variations in brands/colors/size will still work.

Acrylic workshop with Peggy Benton:

- Set of acrylic paints (100ml of each: titanium white, mars black, primary yellow, primary red, primary blue, and pthalo green)
- Canvases (16x20 inch and 12x24 inch)
- #3 Fan brush
- #8 Flat brush
- Palette knife
- Spritzer bottle for water
- Water jar
- Paper towels
- Palette (paper plate)

Watercolor Hike with Hallie Zolynski:

- Watercolor pan set
- Paintbrush
- 6x8 Watercolor Block (or watercolor paper that is taped to a firm surface like cardboard)

Bring Your Own

Apron/painting clothes: Remember that we'll be working in the elements, and with materials that can stain fabric, so please remember to dress accordingly!

Easels: While not necessarily required, if you want one there are a limited number of easels available for loan with a deposit on a first come, first served basis. Or bring your own.

Frames: Consider bringing a frame for your work at the gallery exhibit. Whether you just want to show off your work or try to sell some art, easel space will be available for framed items. All unframed items will be displayed from a wire with clothes pins.

Morning:

- **8-9AM** Coffee Hour / Sign in at World Mining Museum
- **9-NOON** Workshop with Peggy Benton in World Mining Museum pavilion

Afternoon:

- **NOON-1PM** Lunch on your own (food truck available)
- **1-3PM Hiking** Workshop with Hallie Zolynski (leaves promptly)
- **3-5PM** Break to continue painting on your own, or prepare work for display

*Participants who opt out of watercolor hiking workshop can go straight to painting/drawing on your own.

Evening:

- **5-8PM** Gallery exhibit
 - Display and / or sell your day's work at the World Mining Museum where it will be seen by the public through the August 15th.
 - Labels will be provided.
